Alexandra Road was a HUGE event, with more than sixty cars entered! Not bad for "just a clubsport" event, and actually saw so many entries that they weren't able to do the usual format of practice and three timed runs.

Unfortunately, and a little bit inevitably there was some vehicular carnage during the day, as Dave Beazer (excuse me if I got the name wrong, as I am only going from what I can find on the results page) crashed his yellow Lotus heavily, and spent some time in hospital with chipped vertebrae. We from HCCC wish you a swift, and complete recovery Dave. Nobody ever wants to see anyone injured, despite all the risks of our sport.

Jamie Harbour put his white Sti wagon off the side when the power all became too much for the tyres, and from the look of it, there is probably a fairly hefty repair bill to be faced there. Luckily for Jamie, the car bore the brunt of the impact, and he was all ok.

The "Jedi hillclimbers" were allowed to enter, so rather as one would expect, they took out first through third overall, chased by Ron Scanlan in the hugely competitive Evo.

Darren Gledhill's Skyline was looking a bit strange on the day. Traditionally his car is a four wheel drive, but damned if it didn't look like he was in "lots of power and rear drive" mode that day. Saturday 14th April 2007 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. PROMOTERS

The promoters of the competition are Harbour Capital Car Club Inc. All correspondence to be sent to : PO Box 4102 Wellington.

2. STATUS

The competition is a Clubsport Advanced Event held in accordance with the National Sporting Code of MotorSport New Zealand and these Supplementary Regulations. THIS EVENT IS A ROUND OF THE ROAD AND TRACK DUAL CAR SPRINT SERIES. The MSNZ permit number is TBA

3. VENUE

The venue for competition is Manfeild Park, Feilding. The circuit is 3.03kms in length. The surface is Bitumen. All sprints will be run in a CLOCKWISE direction.

4. OFFICIALS

5. ENTRIES

An entry fee of \$80 MUST accompany the official entry form and be received by the secretary before 5pm on Friday 30th March 2007.

Late entries will be accepted until 8pm Thursday 12th April 2007. Late entry fee is \$100.00

All entries must be on the official entry form, and accompanied by the entry fee. Cheques are to be made payable to: Harbour Capital Car Club.

Entry is limited to a maximum of 50 competitors ONLY.

No Single Seater Cars will be permitted to enter this event.

Should the number of entries exceed 50 the organizers will compile a Reserve Entry List. These entrants will be advised and will be required to attend Safety Audit & Documentation. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if less than 30 entries are received by 7th April 2007.

Competitors who enter but withdraw before Friday 6th of April will receive a full refund. Withdrawals after this date, the club will retain 50% of the entry fee to cover fixed costs.

Please indicate on the entry form if you are prepared to take a helper / marshal for a ride. This is a way we can say thanks.

6. DOCUMENTATION AND SAFETY AUDIT

Documentation and safety audits for Wellington based cars will be held on Thursday 12th April 2007 at Vehicle Testing New Zealand (VTNZ) Porirua, 10 Titahi Bay Road between 6.00pm and 8.00pm.

Documentation and safety audits for out of town cars will be on the day at Manfeild, between 8.30am, and 9.30am. Cars arriving after 9.30am will not be accepted except at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Safety Audits will be as per Appendix 2, Schedule A of the NZ Motorsport Manual Edition 33. Vehicles fitted with an appropriate roll cage, seat belts and safety equipment as per Schedule A will be allowed to carry passengers.

Checks will be carried out on all vehicles with entries in their log books requiring them, as well as all cars without log books and any other at the scrutineers discretion, prior to the start of sprinting.

ALL DRIVERS MUST POSSESS AND PRODUCE FOR INSPECTION THE FOLLOWING:

- a) Current MotorSport New Zealand affiliated car club membership card.
- b) Current MotorSport New Zealand competition license. Minimum Clubsport status.
- c) Protective helmet and clothing, fire extinguisher as specified in the current MSNZ Manual.

7. DRIVERS BRIEFING

This will take place, on the dummy grid, at the entrance to the track at 9.45am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory. A roll call of all drivers will be held.

8. SPRINTING

Sprinting will be from 10.00am and will be finished by 4.30pm.

Sprinting will consist of up to 8 pairs of cars on the circuit at any one time.

Sprints will consist of one standing and 2 flying laps. The three laps will be timed individually. The fastest recorded lap time will be used for the official results.

There will be no restriction on the number of sprints you do. All sprints will be timed.

All drivers and crew are to keep the sprinting to the track only, and speeding in the pits or off track testing around the streets of Feilding will not be tolerated.

9. PHOTOGRAPHER

Official photographer(s) will be present at the event and will be taking photos of competitors throughout the day. Please indicate on your entry form if you DO NOT wish the photographer(s) to contact you. There is no obligation to purchase any photos.

10. CLASSES

The following classes will apply:

A 3 & 4 cyl. under 2000cc non turbo

B 4 cyl. turbo, rotaries, 5-6-8 cyl. & diesels

C 6 cyl. turbo, turbo rotaries, 4WD and above

11. RESULTS

It is our intention throughout the day to post times on the notice board near the timing hut. Official times and results will be made available at the after match gathering.






